Ouestions and Answers

Q. How do we generate money?
A. You will receive 15 cents for every pound of clothing you collect.

Q. How does clothing pick up work?
A. It's as simple as 1,2,3....

- 1. Fill in an agreement form
- 2. Book a date for your clothing drive
 - 3. Promote the clothing drive
- 4. Collect donation bags (min. 20 bags)
- 5. Receive funds for your cause *There can be regularly scheduled pick up for bigger schools on a more ongoing basis.

Q. How do I promote my clothing drive?

A. You can create awareness by placing posters in high traffic areas,

placing announcements in your newsletter and e-blasts, distributing

flyers reminding people to collect
