| <p>Power Up!: During Power Up! we will alternate between different academic programming to support a variety of learning areas. We will run programming to support reading, science, and math for all ages.</p> | <p>Road Code: Safe driving principles and provides opportunities for youth to discuss ways to avoid risky behaviors such as distracted or impaired driving. It can help teens who are preparing to take their driver's license test and it can be a great way to introduce concepts of safety both as a driver and as a passenger. (Ages 13+)</p> | <p>Art Attack!: Participants will have the opportunity to create fun, simple crafts during this time using simple materials!</p> | <p>Get in the Game: During this time, participants will get the opportunity to move their bodies, work on skill development and teamwork. Each day we will focus on being physically active for at least 30 minutes.</p> |
| <p>Homework Help: This program is intended to improve children and youth's retention and success in school by providing help with their homework and assignments.</p> | <p>Kids Tech Nation: This program aims to increase children's exposure to digital skills, coding concepts, internet safety, and computational thinking. Science, technology, engineering, and math are the skills of the future. This program provides opportunity to learn these skills through practice and guided work. (Ages 8+)</p> | <p>Art Club: Children and youth get to explore and utilize their creativity skills in this fun and engaging art program. Staff will be using different mediums in inspiring children and youth to create unique pieces of art each week.</p> | <p>Forest Academy: Children and youth will have the opportunity to participate in Club programming, outdoors! Activities will promote open-ended, creative play and learning. Please note, participants will require suitable outdoor clothing.
